## Our Mission Statement

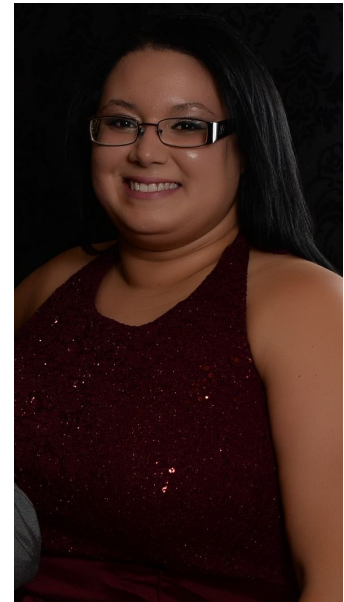
Our goal is to provide and maintain a safe and nurturing learning environment for children.
